	<p>Occupational therapy supports people who have difficulties that prevent them from doing activities that are part of everyday life</p>

## How can the occupational therapy team help?

They can:

	<p>Advise on managing difficulties caused by a disability or loss of ability</p>
	<p>Give you equipment and adaptations to support daily living and personal care</p>
	<p>Support you moving house if it cannot be adapted</p>

## Who can use the service?





To use this service the child or young person must:






	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Be a child or young person under the age of 18</li><li>• Have a permanent or substantial occupational therapy need</li></ul>
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## How do I get occupational therapy?

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## What happens next?

	<p>If your referral is accepted you will be put on a waiting list to be seen by the occupational therapy team</p>
	<p>Children and young people with more serious needs will be seen first</p>
	<p>When it is your turn an occupational therapist will come and visit you at home</p>
	<p>The occupational therapist will assess your occupational therapy needs</p>

	<p>A support plan is then made outlining what help can be offered</p>
	<p>If you are happy with the plan it will be put into action</p>
	<p>Whilst waiting for the support offered, you are put on a review list</p>
	<p>The support plan is checked to make sure progress is made and needs are met</p>
	<p>Once your occupational therapy needs are met the Occupational Therapy team stops working with you</p>
