Leicester City Council provides social care and special educational needs transport for:


Some children and young people with special educational needs and disabilities
Looked after children
Certain children and young people attending school or college
Adults with special or medical needs

What transport services to Leicester City Council offer?



The Council has its own drivers and buses but also works with transport companies

If you meet the assessment criteria Leicester City Council transport can be used to take:



Children to hospital, schools and overnight short breaks



Children from where they are living to meet their parents



Trips for special needs schools and day time activities



Certain adults travelling from home to day care or to community centres



Certain adults with special needs to work placements



There is also a dial-a-ride service for people with special and medical needs who can't use public transport

Special Educational Needs Parent Contracts



Parents who have a special educational needs parent contract with Leicester City Council can claim back the cost for transport.
