is available. Boxes, baskets etc. which contain resources should be clearly labelled with text and or provide a visual indication of what's inside.  As more research has been carried out on how children learn, there has been an increasing shift away from plastic resources and instead, offering more natural and open-ended resources.  As well as offering resources that children already know, there should also be opportunities to explore beyond their familiar reference.  Wall displays should be at child height, so children are able to interact with them.  Children's achievements should be displayed showing the process of learning rather than the end product.  Children and their families' diversity and uniqueness should be celebrated by showing positive images in displays and in practice.  Everything on offer in the environment should reflect and encourage all areas of diversity equally.
